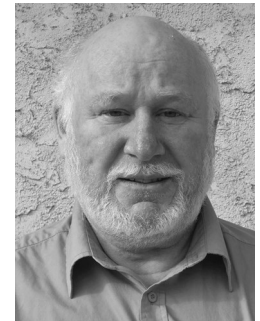

# Missionary of the Month

## PETER MIERAU - Child Evangelism Fellowship

**Native and Culture Ministry:** I like presenting the gospel with the First Nations children. The first thing I have to do is to get rid of "big" words and concepts. The good thing about Native, and foreign missions, is that the gospel can be presented and understood because it is a message for all the people on earth. There are very few changes when presenting the gospel except in keeping presentation in simple words. Native children today face many obstacles to attending clubs and Sunday schools, because the pow-wow's and other native ceremonies are very important to them. A believer is usually shunned for his/her faith and the missionaries are their greatest supporters. Working with "native missionaries" is rewarding to see the gospel reaching lost children in a very different culture. In praying for native presentations, prayers are needed for spiritual protection, because it is usually a spiritual battle and reaching a child/adult is a great victory. Please pray for the children that are believers, for they face challenges in the "spiritual realms."
